Report, 2007 CCLS Annual General Meeting

There has been no new applicants this year to the Board of Examiners for P.E.I. Land Surveyors.

The Complaints and Discipline Committee had a busy year with three complaints from 2006 (06-1, 06-2 & 06-3) still active and one new complaint. The new complaint was dismissed by the Committee. Complaint 06-3 required a formal hearing be performed. Based on the findings of the hearing, and subsequent Committee meetings, Complaints 06-3 and 06-2 were dismissed.

It was noted that if the surveyors involved in the Complaints had supplied more supporting evidence to the Committee a hearing would not have been required. APEILS Act has to be reviewed to give the surveyor and the Committee more guidelines in these matters.

Complaint 06-1 dealt with the placement of survey markers in a position that the surveyor did not certify. The surveyor was asked by the Committee to remove the survey markers. The surveyor complied with the Committee's request.

A Copyright Proposal Committee was struck this year to review the fact that the P.E.I. Government was scanning the filed survey plans (1968 to present) at the Registry Offices and supplying digital copies to the public for printing. The Committee is to prepare a proposal to address the management of the digital survey plans.
